Our new Secretary Becky Ferguson is settling in as is Shona Collins who took over as Minute Secretary from Becky. However, sadly I have to report that Kieran Rorie has had to give up as his 3rd year of studies at University is being spent abroad, and we wish him well for that. By the time our AGM comes round in September we hope to get the posts of Chairperson and Deputy filled as well.

Summer is a busy season for us. We have a stall at the Wellbeing Event on 22nd May (see next page) and are all looking forward to our Gala Day on 4th June. We will have our usual stall there too and all those attending will be able to give their views and suggestions on the proposed Gateway Art Project, which was mentioned in the Spring Bulletin. We believe it is worthwhile to celebrate the past 50 years and the changes to this area in that recent period of time. Do visit the stall and give us your opinions on what you would like to see.

Shopping Centre Development

Can we make it clear at this point that the Art Sculpture at the corner of Westhill Drive and Old Skene Road, at the Roundabout, was a private contract between the Shopping Centre owners and their chosen artist as part of the planning permission granted for the extra shop units. There is always a Percent for Art requirement on larger applications, especially in town centre developments. It has nothing to do with WECC but, regardless of some website/ Facebook comment, we find it rather attractive and amusing.

Unfortunately we have to report that WECC has not been successful in getting a barrier erected at the exit beside the Vets onto the crossing on Westhill Drive. The owners of the Shopping Centre have erected a fairly large notice to warn people, especially parents, of the danger of cars not stopping and to make sure to check before attempting to cross. All drivers do not always stop at pedestrian crossings.

Path from Hillside Road to Eastside Drive

We are still working towards keeping the path from Hillside to Eastside open for pedestrians. Many residents in that area are also keeping up the pressure on Aberdeenshire Council on this issue as well. The Community Council have raised questions about priorities for spending in recent annual budget plans for the services covering such repairs and improvements. We appreciate that resources are tight but we do emphasise the importance of listening to communities, especially in times of funding shortages.

Finally, let us end on a positive note! You will read on page 9 there is a move to revive the Gardening Competition in the town, which up until about 3 years ago was a regular annual feature in the calendar. After the difficulty of trying, with no success, to get someone to take on what Bill Loudon did for many years, two of our Aberdeenshire Councillors, Iris Walker and Ron McKail, are willing to do their best to get it going again. There are so many beautiful gardens in the town and the silver cups from before are just waiting to be won again! We do hope for success with this and appreciate the initiative shown by the Councillors.

Hopefully we can now enjoy some lovely warm summer days over the coming months after a cold Spring.

In many of my previous bulletin articles I have talked about the importance of volunteers in our community. These are the people who organise and run activities for our young and old and serve on the committees which run our leisure facilities, sports clubs and halls. The trimming of budgets and pressure on centrally provided funding continues to make the jobs our volunteers do much more difficult.

In order to assist community groups there are, however, sources of funding which are becoming increasingly important in helping to maintain activities and services which we take for granted. In our area the Garioch Partnership are a tremendous provider of advice and assistance for organisations wanting to access these public funds. The partnership know how to formulate bids for funding and more importantly who to apply to. They can guide applicants through the process and details of funding applications and are an important asset for local community organisations.

Aberdeenshire Council also provide funding for community organisations. This can be accessed through the area top-up budgets of Aberdeenshire's six area committees. In Westhill that means the Garioch Area Committee. The advantages of local councillors being able to direct funding to local organisations through the top-up budget has now been prioritised by Aberdeenshire Council. This has resulted in each top-up budget being doubled, meaning more funding is now available for eligible community organisations and projects in our area.

Emergency Contact Disc

Aberdeenshire Council's Garioch and North Marr Community Safety Group is promoting an Emergency Contact Disc for motorists to place into the redundant tax disc holder on their windscreen. The details on the disc, completed by the car owner, contains the phone number of next of kin and very importantly medical alert information. The disc which folds inwards cannot be viewed by passers-by. In the event of a medical emergency or a road traffic accident which renders the driver unconscious the details provided will be of considerable help to paramedics or police or fire and rescue services. They are able to contact next of kin and having medical information which is not normally accessible at the scene of the accident could ensure a better outcome for the injured driver.

This safety initiative has been endorsed and supported by Police, Scottish Ambulance Service and the Fire and Rescue Service.

The Emergency Contact Disc can be used alongside existing medical alert products like bracelets and necklaces.

Top Up Grant Budget of £104,000 Available for Garioch Community Projects

Garioch Area Committee for the coming year has £104,000 allocated in its budget allowing the Area Committee to respond to applications from community based groups which have a project that meets local needs and fits the aims of Aberdeenshire Council relating to social and economic development. If your constituted group has a project which would benefit from a grant where costs cannot be met from normal budgets the criteria for applying includes:-*Improving towns and villages; Community Action Plans; *A Town Centre First approach; *The Local Community Plan; *Promoting resilient communities, wellbeing, and tackling inequality; *The development of services for young people; *Projects which are supported by a community organisation for the benefit of the wider community.

The maximum payment for any project will be £10,000. Funding is intended for use as part of a wider funding package with a maximum contribution of 75% and for grants in excess of £3,000 your group's constitution and your latest statement of accounts is required.

If your group has a project which fits the criteria please consider submitting your application sooner rather than later before this budget is spent. BILL'S GARDENING CORNER – Rainbow colours

Now the weather has started to improve and the ground is warming up nicely, you can plant out summer bedding, but keep an eye out for late frost, water them in with a liquid feed and this will help them to get established.

Keep sweet peas well-watered or the buds may drop off in dry weather; once they start blooming pick regularly to produce more flowers. Stake tall growing plants like delphiniums while still young, the plants will soon cover the canes.

The weeds are growing fast in the warmer weather, hoe the ground and borders once a week on dry days to control them. Tough weeds like ground elder can be sprayed with weedkiller, just keep the spray from getting onto your flowers and other pants.

Enjoy your garden with all the summer colours, don't forget to feed your grass after cutting once a week, it will certainly thank you for it.

We have seen several clients lately who have been the victims of a PPI scam which callously targets older and vulnerable people. If you have such a person in your family, they may have been contacted by a caller who has told them they are eligible for PPI repayment, mentioning a substantial figure. They ask for upfront administration fees to be paid, in such a way that is impossible to trace their identity, often by PaySafeCard via PayPoint and MoneyGrams. The victim pays this first amount and then is 'milked' for more money, in increasing amounts, always with plausible reasons. Victims are asked to disclose the PaySafeCard PIN over the phone despite warnings on the ticket never to do so. The scammers are very persuasive, persisting even when the victim has told them that they know it is a scam, trying to regain the victim's confidence. If in any doubt, contact SWACAB for advice.



We would like your help with something that effects all of us who work in the community and that's locating where your patient/client lives! A lot of time can be wasted looking for a property and we have all had the experience of calling at the wrong house, much to everyone's embarrassment! Some of the streets in Westhill don't have an obvious numbering system of odd and even numbers on either side. Many of the more rural locations are a challenge to find and even more so in the dark. Most homes do have a number on the door but often it can't be seen from the road. Over the years instructions given to us to find a house have been "turn after you see the hay bales in the field" and "we are the house behind the one with the red door". Try to imagine you don't know where you live and see what improvements could be made for signs to and the numbering of your property to help us find you. Not everyone will be able to fix a sign on the outside of their property, but if you are expecting a visit from the Doctor, Nurse or anyone from the Health and Social Care Team, perhaps you could put a visible number in the front window to help us get to you.

On another topic, some of you will be changing the design of your gardens at this time of year, so now is the time to think carefully about where you will place things like a garden ornament, planter and garden edging. Many can become trip hazards and cause falls if put close to paths or near washing lines. When you are hanging out the washing, it is natural not to pay attention to where you put your feet and you could easily fall over the decorative item. Also if you are adding steps to part of the garden make them deep and wide enough for your whole foot and make the edges of the step obvious by using a different colour stone for each step. If you have a lot of steps then definitely think about having a rail to steady yourself. This advice is not just for someone with mobility issues, good planning now can save a fall and broken leg later. Let's hope we have a good summer to enjoy our gardens this year.

There are over 10 million fully searchable pages, featuring more than 200 newspaper titles, dating from 1710 to 1955, from all over the UK and Ireland. Local newspapers include the Aberdeen, Banffshire and Stonehaven Journals, the Peterhead Sentinel, Aberdeen Evening Express and Aberdeen Herald.

British Newspaper Archive is a rich source of news articles which cover every aspect of news from major events such as the World Wars and sinking of the Titanic to local community happenings.

Family history enthusiasts can view birth, marriage and death notices as well as related announcements such as engagements, anniversaries, in memoriam, obituaries, birthdays and congratulations.

In addition users can view illustrations, such as photographs, maps and editorial cartoons, advertisements, including classifieds and shipping notices, and letters to the editor

There is a My Research area where you can store and organise articles you have viewed for future access. Notes can also be added to any of the articles.

It's free to search but to view the original newspaper pages you need to be in one of our libraries and sign in to the service (after registering the first time)

The past two months have been the busiest ever at the Shed averaging over 90 visitors a week. Here is a snapshot of some of the activities going on.

Study – A university researcher studying depression came to interview at the Shed because she wanted a control group (i.e. people without depression). We were very flattered because of course we aim to combat loneliness and depression by having a men's shed; so it seems to be working. She got a good result and we had an interesting time answering the questions.

The Bailies o'Bennachie – Their shed was broken into and their garden tools stolen. We gave them free pick of tools we have had donated and refurbished. Just think that your old garden tool you didn't need any more may now be in the hands of a Bailie up on Bennachie. Other sad stories were told by flood victims who had their garden tools stolen while they were drying out their houses and we were able to help them too.

Many mowers have been saved from landfill and there seems to be a never ending supply of garden bench ends needing a lick of paint and new wood. We continue to make benches and planters and are involved with the children's hospital at ARI to make a garden seat for them.

3D printer – We were very generously offered a 3D printer which was no longer used by Plexus, an oil services company. Unfortunately due to the size and the dust it would cause we could not take it. Looking at it raised enough interest that we are going to buy one in the near future. 3D printing has already been used in the shed to make 'wrought iron' gates for the model railway with 'Iron Works' printed in them and to make shapes for SensationALL. Take a look at *thingiverse.com/categories* if you are interested in what can be done.

Talks – Talks by Jim Fiddes of Skene Heritage Society were well attended. 'A walk along old Skene Road' explained how there used to be an inn named after every mile and the history of many of the buildings. His second talk on the winning and uses of granite was equally interesting. On a more practical theme the pharmacist from Lloyds came to talk about the information and advice they can provide to complement the GP service.

Skene Parish Church

Many of us enjoy walking – whether it's getting out into the hills, talking a stroll at the beach or venturing further afield. And walking not only exercises our bodies. It can also give us an opportunity help to clear our heads. As Prospero says in *The Tempest*, "A turn or two l'Il walk, to still my beating mind."

The picture is from Plakias Hill in Crete. The view was an amazing reward for a tough walk. I confess that we did ring the bell.

One of things I love about walking is getting time for proper conversations. As you fall in step with someone else, negotiating the path shoulder to shoulder, you quickly go beyond polite chit-chat and into deep discussions. There can also be a wonderful sense of camaraderie when you are walking together in silence, absorbing the view and thinking your own thoughts.

The bible often portrays God as the best available walking companion in life. It reveals that the best, most fulfilling lives are those marked by walking in step with God. Enoch, a man from the Old Testament, is described simply as someone who walked with God. Later in the New Testament we are told, Enoch's testimony was that he pleased God. When King Solomon speaks at the grand opening of the temple, the most magnificent of buildings, he asks that God would incline the hearts of the people to Him, so that they would walk in his ways.

To walk with God is to choose to listen to Him, to put our trust in Him and to follow His advice and commands. It is to bring our lives in line with Him, which is not an easy ask. But as Solomon reminds us, God's faithfulness is such that He never walks out on us.

Of course when you are walking in step with someone, you keep pace with them. It makes sense that the God who made us, and made all of creation, would know the best speed for our lives. Sometimes it is tempting to rush ahead or to try and sustain a lifestyle which is more about the mad dash than a steady flow. God sometimes works much slower than we like and we often make a mess by not being sufficiently patient. And if God is not within our consciousness, we will struggle to find the right rhythm.

What is impacting the pace of your life? What direction are you going on? Do you ever even have enough space and time to think about these questions? Or is it just, head down and get on with it until a crisis hits and brings you up short?

There is a beautiful phrase in the psalms which talks about God rescuing the psalmist and bringing them to a spacious place. Perhaps the next time you are out walking, and you come to a **spacious place**, you should ask yourself – am I in step with the one who knows the very beat and rhythm of my heart?

In five other studies, patients who were suffering from chronic illness or cancer were shown to have benefited from a range of creative pursuits, for example painting, drawing, pottery, photography and sewing. If these are proven to help patients, surely they are beneficial to us all by boosting our immune systems. Creating something stimulates the brain to make new connections. It can give you a sense of achievement and boost your feel-good hormones. If we encourage children to be creative too, we would be preparing them for a healthy future. Children have a wonderful uninhibited attitude to art, and create with enthusiasm without worrying about the end result. If you're an adult having a go at it for the first time in years, tap in to your inner child and never mind how it might turn out. You can always throw it away if you don't like it. It's in the doing that you can lose yourself and forget the troubles of the world. Whatever your age or ability, learning something new like playing a musical instrument, making art or craft can be liberating.

As a physio I am of course keen to encourage activities that are physically beneficial, so would be happy to see more people choosing to take up golf or ballroom dancing, learning to abseil or scuba dive. If your job is already an active one however, then it's perfectly acceptable for you to choose to take up a less physical activity, like knitting or learning to play the piano.

We're very lucky in Westhill, in that there are lots of groups and associations which provide the opportunity to be creative with the support of others. The Men's Shed is a good example, as well as the numerous evening classes on offer at the community centre. You don't have to go far to view and appreciate other people's creations either. Wandering round an art gallery, a lovely garden or park, or attending a concert are great for inspiration and refreshment, without the demands of a response. That's with your mobile phone off, of course.

Albert Einstein said that "Creativity is intelligence having fun". So get out there and join a choir, catch a fish or write poetry. Have fun, and be healthy!

Pond Restoration work at Arnhall Moss Local Nature Reserve

Ponds between Arnhall Moss Local Nature reserve and Denman Park in Westhill, have recently been restored for the benefit of wildlife and visitors.

Working in partnership with Froglife, the UK reptile and amphibian conservation charity the Arnhall Moss Advisory Group and Aberdeenshire Council have



restored a series of three ponds running between Arnhall Moss and Denman Park in Westhill.

Work carried out in February was jointly funded by Froglife's Scottish Dragon Finder project (funded by the Heritage Lottery Fund) and Aberdeenshire Council. The ponds have been opened up and restored. A dipping platform and some interpretation boards have been added.

Westhill and District councillor Iris Walker, a member of the Arnhall Moss Advisory Group, said the group is delighted that the work is completed. "The first phase involved felling selected trees from around the ponds – this opened up the area removing species which are not really suited to growing by the ponds," she said. "Very little management work has been done on the ponds over the years and this has been a great opportunity to tidy the area up and enhance it for wildlife all at the same time"

Garioch Area Ranger Alison Sutherland regularly uses the area for pond dipping with local primary schools and biology students from Westhill Academy. She said: "The current dipping results do not generally show many invertebrates and no amphibians. We very much hope this situation will improve." Alison also hopes local people will help keep the ponds clean and litter free in future, as a big part of this project is the removal of broken bottles, tyres, shopping trollies and other rubbish.

Officers from Froglife will be back in the late spring to help run some volunteer days and training days at Arnhall, this is likely to include ponds dipping and training on how to create habitat for amphibians.
