

# Chairperson's Report

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself, I'm Shona Collins. I have lived in Westhill for many years and work here too. Last year I got involved in our community by volunteering to join the Community Council. Now, since the AGM in September, I find myself as the new Chairperson! I will do my best to work with members of our CC to achieve the best for this community. We have vacancies, you can come along to one of our meetings held on the second Thursday of every month at the Holiday Inn, starting at 7pm. All residents are welcome. We do need a new Minutes Secretary, a small honorarium is given for this position.

### **AFC Football Stadium**

Most residents will be aware of the proposal by Aberdeen Football Club to move from their home ground at Pittodrie and relocate to a new stadium right on the edge of Westhill. There are strong concerns being expressed locally and we outlined the main ones in the Autumn issue. There is an active campaign being mounted by 'No Kingsford Stadium Group' and they have an article in this issue on page 15. They also delivered a newsletter recently to households in Westhill and Kingswells. We are aware of many of their concerns but we are also aware that other residents are supportive of the development. We hosted a public meeting on 1st November in the Holiday Inn, which was attended by almost 300 people, to discuss the proposal. The meeting was well chaired by Douglas Milne Garioch Area Manager, in a fair and even handed way. The various concerns were well aired but we were not able to provide all the answers at this stage.

AFC are aiming to submit the planning application to Aberdeen City Council in the next month and they are running a public feedback event at Pittodrie on 24th November, prior to this submission. More details of this event will be posted on our website <a href="https://www.westhillelrick.org">www.westhillelrick.org</a>. WECC are continuing to hold a neutral stance on this as we do not have all the detail at this time. You can be notified of new posts on the website by clicking on the 'follow' button in bottom right-hand corner of home page and adding your email address. The public will be notified on how to support or object to the application to Aberdeen City Council and the date by which these have to be submitted.

# **Gateway Project**

People are asking what's this Question Mark at the entrance to Westhill? This has been put there by WECC to try and generate interest. What we want is to get residents involved in coming up with ideas for a piece of art that could depict the huge changes in this community over the past 50 years. From being a very rural agricultural area in the late 1960's to this place we now live in which has not only got a large residential population but because of the rapid expansion of the Oil and Gas industry, was given the title of the home of Global SubSea Engineering! We want to establish a clear identity for Westhill and Elrick and celebrate by hopefully getting a suitable piece of Public Art that can reflect these changes. # WESTHILL GATEWAY ART PROJECT

YOUR QUESTION TO ANSWER...

You may have seen it -- a white question mark next to the Tesco roundabout in Westhill. (see photo on front cover).

The wooden structure marks a spot earmarked for a piece of public art to celebrate the town's 50th birthday (in 2018).

The question is what kind of piece of public art should eventually occupy this space?

Westhill and Elrick Community Council (WECC) is looking to residents to help answer that question.

We intend to carry out a public consultation in due course on the themes to be incorporated into the final art piece and how they might represent the heritage and current status of the town.

Meantime, we hope our temporary installation will inspire ideas and conversation!

Preliminary discussions about using this site have taken place between WECC and Aberdeenshire Council officers, who have been supportive to date.

The chosen piece would be of significant size but proportionate to its site. To pay for the design and construction, WECC is hoping to secure grants reserved for public art.

This artwork is intended to symbolize the transition of Westhill's community from a small predominantly agricultural one, to a substantial and thriving one firmly related to international oil and gas services. It should reflect the confidence in the future of Westhill.

If funding can be found, a brief will be drawn up and an artist appointed.

# Councillor David Aitchison

The proposed football stadium development by Aberdeen FC continues to be discussed in our community and I am often asked for information on the progress and timescale of what is proposed. The most recent information I have is that the football club are likely to make their formal planning application by the end of the year. This means that Aberdeen City Council are unlikely to make a decision on the application before the local council elections in May.

Winter is now with us and I would encourage everyone to be mindful of the vulnerable members of our community. A little help goes a long way, whether that is clearing an elderly neighbour's path of snow or gritting their driveway when you are doing your own. The council and councillors are aware and appreciative of the many positive actions taken by residents throughout the year. The actions and help for our vulnerable friends and neighbours is particularly appreciated during the winter.

Examples of what happens naturally within our communities in Aberdeenshire during spells of winter weather were heard at the recent meeting of Infrastructure Services Committee. At this meeting councillors agreed to the proposal for a snow warden scheme. This scheme will help communities to help themselves. It was also agreed that the council would double the number of large grit bins at council recycling centres to improve public access to salt and grit.

I can be consulted at any time by telephone or email on any issue and also hold monthly surgeries at Westhill Library on the first Wednesday of the month from 6-7pm.

My next surgery dates are Wednesday 7 December, Wednesday 1 February 2017 and Wednesday 1 March 2017.

## **Occasional Licenses**

A timely reminder if you are organising a Christmas do or fundraiser where alcohol will be served in unlicensed premises, you need to apply for an occasional license six weeks prior to the event. ### Trees

Many residents in Westhill contact me about trees. The space I have here doesn't allow me to list the raft of benefits trees have on our environment, but sometimes trees can be seen as a problem. Aberdeenshire Council's policy states that they will not prune or remove trees to increase light or improve a satellite signal for a property; trees will be pruned or removed if damaged, or dangerous to property or pedestrians in the area. Landscape Services do have a programme of maintenance for trees in Westhill and upcoming work will include the removal of unsafe poplar trees.

# **BT Payphone Consultation**

BT are currently undergoing a consultation on intended payphone removals. There are two payphones in Westhill included in the consultation. Records show that the payphone on Old Skene Road has been used once in the last twelve months and the payphone on Enterprise Drive, 50 times. Both are earmarked for removal. The consultation ends on 28th November and you should direct any comments to Aberdeenshire Council before that date.

# Planning Issues

At a recent Garioch Area Committee meeting, councillors discussed the engagement process of the Local Development Plan (or the LDP) which is refreshed every few years and sets out statements of the policies Aberdeenshire will use for assessing planning applications and confirms the principle of development on sites across Aberdeenshire. Planning can be a dry subject and sometimes residents don't find out about a planning application which may affect them until it is reported in the press. Aberdeenshire Council publish a weekly list of new applications so it is worth looking them up if you are interested in what is going on in the area. Getting involved in the Community Council is also a good way of finding out more as they, as statutory consultees, are kept up to date with new applications. Community Councils are also involved in the LDP process, being invited to put forward possible sites to be included in the LDP. As a planning authority, Aberdeenshire is always looking for new ways to engage with residents, particularly hard to reach groups such as the young and the elderly. If you have any ideas on how to improve engagement on the planning system or would like to find out more, please get in touch.

## **Near Misses on Westhill Zebra Crossings**

In the Autumn Bulletin I wrote about concerns regarding near accidents on two zebra crossings on Westhill Drive, namely the crossings between the hotel and the shopping centre and also the crossing beside the bus stop near to Kinmundy. This Bulletin item resulted in the receipt of several emails expressing mixed views on who was responsible for the 'near misses'. For some, whilst appreciating that pedestrians have the right of way, they were failing to give consideration to oncoming vehicles. They were striding on to the zebra crossing without looking in either direction to check oncoming traffic and without checking whether the vehicle driver had seen them. The message is clear that pedestrians have a responsibility to confirm it is safe to cross on the zebra. For others, the responsibility and blame for what could have been a fatality lies with the vehicle driver approaching too fast and completely disregarding somebody on the zebra crossing.

Anecdotal evidence suggests that there have been many 'close calls' on both these crossings on Westhill Drive.

As a follow up to the emails and phone calls received I contacted Aberdeenshire Council Roads officers to raise the profile of this road safety issue. Appropriate checks have since been carried out by council staff and it has been confirmed both zebra crossing fully comply with all appropriate Roads and Traffic Regulations. Officers also point out that there is no data available to indicate an increase in accidents at these zebra crossings. No further action is therefore planned, mainly on the basis there is no hard evidence to indicate there is a safety problem to pedestrians. For many in Westhill, however, they would disagree but what is required is evidence before any action will be considered.

As a suggestion, if you have been involved in a near accident or have suggestions as to improving safety at these locations, could I ask you to share this information with me. I will then collate it (will not use your personal information) and report it to Council Officers and to Police Scotland.

# No Kingsford Stadium Group

What is planned? Aberdeen Football Club (AFC) is proposing to build a 20,000 seater stadium, plus a football training academy with 7 floodlit pitches just outside Westhill, behind the Lawsondale playing fields. The site is just within the Aberdeen City Boundary, which

means that Aberdeenshire residents will be most affected, but it will be Aberdeen city councillors who will decide if the plans are approved.

Who are we? We are concerned local residents who formed the group to oppose this development because of the impact that it will have on our community. Key issues are listed below:



**Loss of Green belt.** The proposed site is on green belt land, which is not designated for development and contrary to the Aberdeen City Development Plan. Previous planning applications for housing and a golf driving range were refused on land adjacent to the site.

**Road Congestion.** The A944 is a busy road and the new AWPR and slip roads were not designed to cope with up to 20,000 additional people using cars and buses to access a facility off the A944. The whole area will be severely congested on match days. Additionally, the A944 will probably require to be closed for a period after a match to enable traffic dispersal (as per current practice at Pittodrie).

**Parking.** There will be insufficient car parking available at the stadium so we are likely to have 100s of cars driving through our quiet streets searching for spaces. AFC have proposed parking permits for residents, which we currently do not have, and do not want.

**Safety.** The stadium is 'shoe-horned' into the site between two potentially hazardous oil and gas pipelines. Fans parking in Westhill, Kingswells or the Park and Ride will walk along the A944 cycle path which is narrow in places. How will emergency vehicles move through and beyond the A944 in heavy traffic?

**Noise and light pollution.** In addition to the regular football season matches, it is likely that the stadium will host football and rugby internationals as well as concerts. We anticipate sound will carry over a wide area. Training pitches will be used in the evenings, bringing unwanted light pollution to houses nearby.

**Visual impact.** The 6-7 storey building will be an imposing structure on entering Westhill, domineering the town. We will lose our semi-rural situation and we feel that this is part of a longer term plan to develop the entire A944 corridor between Kingswells and Westhill.

**What happens next?** Once the full planning application is submitted, the public have just 4 weeks to send letters of objection. We don't have a date for this yet but we will keep you posted!

The **3D** printer has arrived (following a generous grant from NEXEN) and we are getting to grips with the complexities of designing the parts to be printed on the PC and then seeing them come out like magic. The **model railway** was designed to be portable, and has recently been on display at two events in Aberdeen, where it is a great attraction that helps to 'spread the Shed' as we say.

We had a fascinating visit from **Barry Golding of the International Men's Shed group**, who gave us his take on development questions. We were pleased to hear that Sheds are now spreading to America, with the first site recently opening in Hawaii, and several more in development throughout the USA and Canada.

### Container for the Men's Shed at the Recycling Centre

We are collecting broken lawnmowers and other equipment in a container at the Recycling Centre in Westhill. This has been supplied by Aberdeenshire Council and is working well with the cooperation of visitors and staff. We are getting a steady flow of petrol driven equipment, mostly mowers but also leaf blowers, hedge trimmers and suchlike. One downside is that the Council has an exclusive contract with a firm for anything electrical, so we cannot get electric mowers, drills, or sanders through this route. If you would like to donate electrical items we would be pleased to receive them directly at the Shed, or if they are too heavy, give us a call and we can arrange for them to be picked up.

The Shed always welcomes new members, so why not drop in and give it a go? We are open on Monday and Friday, 10-4, and Wednesday, 3-8. You will find us directly behind the swimming pool.

## The Physio says – Back pain myths: time they were busted!

With a recently published set of leaflets, The Chartered Society of Physiotherapy (CSP) is 'busting myths' about back pain, and reinforcing what the latest evidence says is best for your back. Below are four myths that many people believe, none of which are helpful in ensuring the speediest recovery from back pain. Find out more at www.csp.org.uk/mythbusters.

The vast majority of sore backs are not life threatening, they can be very painful, they're an annoying inconvenience, and very common. Usually the pain goes up and down for a number of weeks, sometimes months, then goes away. In a few very rare cases the cause is serious and should be dealt with right away by a doctor. For example someone who is in constant pain day and night, or who has had a recent injury or fall, should see a doctor. These are two of a number of signs which doctors and physios are trained to watch out for in our patients. If you're worried then we can assess you and advise. Otherwise learn from these myths below. The replies relate to the majority of cases of back pain.

"Moving will make my back worse" – not true. The spine is a series of joints and all joints like movement. Your spinal discs depend on it for their supply of nutrients. There's no need to fear bending and twisting. Stay active, start moving gently and slowly increase how much you do.

"I should avoid exercise, especially weight training" – not true. There's no reason why you shouldn't continue to exercise when your back is sore. Continuing with regular activities can help you recover more quickly. If weight training is something you normally do, you can continue this within reason.

"A scan will show me exactly what's wrong" – sometimes it can, but more often than not, it shows normal age-related changes which people who don't have any back pain have as well. Being told you have wear and tear on a scan can cause unnecessary fear and make you reluctant to move, slowing your recovery. This is why GPs rarely recommend having an X-ray or scan.

"Pain equals damage" – not necessarily true. When something hurts, it's not always a sign that it's broken or injured. If you cut your finger or sprain your ankle, there's an obvious cause of the pain. It's useful to have that pain as it makes you change your behaviour, by avoiding bending the cut finger until it heals, or by limping to avoid stressing the ankle until the swelling has gone down. If you have a sore back, that pain is often unhelpful as it can stop you moving, which in itself slows recovery. The pain often comes from muscle spasm or tension, and how much pain you perceive is influenced by all sorts of things. Your past experiences of back pain, how stressed you are in your job, or at home, can each change your perception. "So why is the pain there?", you might ask. That can be harder to answer. Maybe it's your body telling you to look after it better! Need more exercise, a healthier diet, less stress? Whatever the reason, physiotherapy can ease your symptoms and speed recovery.
