

Office Bearers Report

Changes at WECC

It is great to see the year roll by with so many different developments in Westhill. There has also been some developments in WECC. We would like to thank the community for their understanding and patience as WECC members worked to resolve a number of internal challenges in the last few months. The outcome of all these has been a change of guard in the leadership of WECC. On 12th July, Mr Chika Edeh and Mr Stuart Bews were elected Interim Chair and Vice Chair respectively till the AGM in September. Mr David Ritchie has also been reappointed as Acting Secretary for the same period. We ask for the continued support of everyone in the community as we work to build on previous successes in making Westhill a welcoming and engaging community for all its residents.

Kingsford

AFC started ground work on phase 1 of the project in July 2018. Phase 1 mainly comprises the community sports hub and training facilities.

WECC have two representatives in the working group that AFC have established which will be the conduit for on-going dialogue between the Club and the local communities. WECC will be engaging with the community to gather their views on how to make use of the facilities and will present those ideas to AFCCT/AFC. Parking at the Shopping Centre

The Westhill Shopping Centre owners are planning to implement an Automatic Number Plate Recognition system in the car park soon. This will allow shoppers to park for up to 3 hours, with no return within the hour. It has been introduced mainly to stop people using the car park as a park and ride. We will be monitoring the impact of this.

Ashdale Hall Update

Ashdale Hall were really pleased with the numbers attending their meeting regarding the future of the hall and its management committee on 4th July. It was a positive meeting with interested parties and a cheese and wine AGM is being held on Wednesday 29th August at 7pm at the hall for all people interested in becoming involved on the management committee.

Westhill Gala

WECC had the a stall at the Gala on 9th June and we were delighted that the sculptor Holger Lonze who we have commissioned to deliver the Gateway Art Project was there with a model of his proposal, which attracted great interest. People were also interested to see on a map of Westhill the many sites around the town that developers have proposed for possible housing land allocations to be incorporated into the next Local Development Plan.

WECC AGM

Our AGM will he held on Thursday 13th September in the Holiday Inn function room, starting at 7pm. The main AGM business will be the report for the year and the financial report. There will be a presentation of prizes to the 'Westhill in Bloom' winners and a brief update from SensationALL on their plans for the Old School. After the AGM we will have our normal monthly meeting. Residents are invited to attend either or both of these meetings.

Gateway Art Project

We were delighted that our sculptor Holger Lonze was able to visit us during Westhill Gala Week. He spent time talking to many residents at the Gala and we were delighted with the positive responses we received. The sculpture will now be in manufacture and on schedule to be unveiled at the end of October. After discussions, we are trying to raise some more funds to landscape the area and make it easily accessible with paths, etc. We are hoping this will be achieved by October too.



Westdyke Recycling Centre Rises to the Challenge

My congratulations to the staff at the Westdyke waste collection depot on achieving a 71% recycling rate, up from 66% in 2015. To put this in perspective, along with Alford and

Banchory who have also achieved similar recycling rates, other depots in the Shire are showing rates which are lower with many falling into the 50% and 60% category.



Good news obviously at Westdyke but the overall recycling for Aberdeenshire when we include our household waste (blue wheelie bins) is less than satisfactory with a recycling rate of only 44%. The challenge set by the Scottish Government which we are required to meet is 60% by 2020 and 70% by 2025. Worth reflecting that 2020 is some sixteen months away. It is also worth noting that the cost to the council of recycling is £29 per ton and the cost of `dumping` our rubbish into landfill is £118 per ton. Clearly a no brainer as to the direction of travel. Could we in Westhill achieve the 60% recycling target by 2020? We can if all of us followed the council recycling policy. Placing garden waste in the black wheelie bin, not using the food waste bin and putting this into the black bin is sadly not uncommon practice.

Addendum

Whilst preparing this an article appeared in the Daily Mail inferring that for councils in the UK their recycling waste was being placed in landfill sites. In discussion with Shire council officers this article does not apply to us or to Scotland for that matter. Material collected via our blue bins is sent to a Paisley company for separation and processing. They have outlets for all the materials we send them; cans, plastics, paper, cardboard, etc. They have up to three outlets for plastics, all of which recycle the material within the UK. These three outlets are long-term relationships which indicate that in a market place inundated with plastic material there is continuity of a recycling service.

Community Safety - Pass Plus

As the Pass Plus driving course funding grant has been reduced by Aberdeenshire Council by £1000, I am very grateful to Westhill and Elrick Community Council for their generous donation of £1000 to encourage locally* newly qualified drivers to avail themselves (whilst funds last) of individual grants of £100 each towards meeting the cost of this 6 hour driving course. My message to parents – if your son or daughter has recently obtained their driving license, please consider encouraging them to apply for this grant. For a newly qualified driver their driving skills will be the beneficiary by having (without test pressures) an additional 6 hours driving experience under the guidance of their driving instructor, hopefully making them more confident and safer. *Local refers to applicants residing in the area covered by the Westhill Bulletin.

Kingsford

Since my last Bulletin report, the status of phase 2 of the Kingsford project remains the same; there is nothing new to report regarding the conditions attached to the planning permission which would allow phase 2 (the stadium) to progress. With regards to phase 1 which includes the training facilities and pavilion, Aberdeen Football Club has had an initial meeting with local community groups to outline

their proposals and start discussions on possible future partnership working and use of facilities. The next meeting is scheduled for September.

Local Development Plan (LDP)

In June I reported that the Main Issues Report would go out for public consultation later this year. This is when you have the chance to comment on the land bids which developers have submitted. This public consultation is now not expected to happen until early 2019, probably January, and will be open for 12 weeks. Sports & Culture Strategy

In July, Aberdeenshire Council launched new strategies for Sports and Culture. To celebrate, staff held a number of great local events. A pop-up ceilidh was held in the library and Circus Modo delivered skills and teambuilding workshops. A family fun afternoon in Westhill is planned for Saturday 25th August with local clubs being invited to showcase their activity. There will be fun at the pool, a badminton leadership course, Book Bug and lots more. This event will showcase how the services within the council will work with key partners, third sector organisations and local residents to deliver a varied programme of activities to encourage more to take part in sports and culture. In previous articles I have often talked about how much our community benefits through participation by volunteers in the clubs and groups which help to make Westhill a great place to live. New to area, working on a new you or just need some new motivation!

JogScotland Westhill, is a fun, friendly local jogging group which is perfect for runners who are new to the area, anyone who wants to get active for the first time or those of us who have been running alone under the cover of darkness as we start our running journey. Nobody is "too slow" to join and nobody gets left behind!

Motivation can also be an issue for most of us and knowing that others will be with you to share the experience of pounding the pavements whatever the weather can often be the difference between staying in or going out. For those of you who think that running clubs are just for those at the front of the pack or those who take their running too seriously, well no! Joining a club is one of the best things that any runner, whatever their level, can do. It can often instigate big improvements in performance and provide lasting memories, experiences and friendship.

We have several runners who joined the group to get to know Westhill and meet some people. Jess moved to Westhill last year and didn't really know the area or anyone living here and heard about the group at Hazlehead parkrun. Not knowing the area, she was worried that she'd get lost going out on her own and wanted somewhere she could meet new people. Our experienced jog leaders have mapped dozens of routes around Westhill that are suitable for runners of every ability and even those who have stayed in the town for decades occasionally find another "new" path that they've never been on.

Many people who take up jogging for the first time do it with a goal in mind – they might want to run in a charity event or join their friends at an organised race. Having a target can be a brilliant motivator, but it's important that it's realistic. Kim Richmond joined in January 2018 after seeing an ad for the Couch to 5K programme. At the time she'd lost the habit of doing regular exercise and wanted something that would not only get her started again, but also help her stick with it.

Kim says: "My experience definitely ticked both boxes, as taking part in the regular C25K sessions was great fun and really improved my fitness, so at the end of the programme I was able to complete (and even enjoy) the Garioch 5K. The friendship and encouragement I got from everyone was a huge help, so much so that since then I've completed several more 5K runs and have even stepped up to running a couple of 10Ks."

So, if you're thinking about taking up running but aren't too sure if it's for you, or if you're running on your own and fancy some friendly, non-competitive and supportive company or just want to get to know Westhill a little better we'd say come along and give it a go. 

This autumn, Skene Parish Church is launching a **Young Heroes Award** as part of the Year of Young People. And we need your help!

Our community is full of inspirational and hard-working young people who are making the most of their abilities and talents. There are young people who are seeking to make a difference in the lives of those around them. Some of our teenagers are coping in exceptional ways with all kinds of difficult situations including bereavement, chronic illness and relational breakdown.



We want to recognise how amazing our young people are and have developed this award with two distinct categories. The criteria are as follows:

YOUNG CARER

Aim: to recognise young people who provide regular and ongoing practical, personal care and/or emotional support to a family member who has a physical, learning or mental disability, or who misuses substances, or where there are issues of domestic violence.

- What is the situation in which the young person (YP) operates in a caring role?
- What is the nature of the support which YP provides?
- Specifically, what are the functions that YP performs?
- · How often and for how long does YP carry out the caring role?
- · How long has YP been doing this?
- In view of YP's age, how exceptional is it that YP can be expected/ is able to do this?

COPING WITH ADVERSITY

Aim: to recognise young people who have

- a) kept smiling against all odds in coping with, or overcoming, serious illness and who deserves to be celebrated for their extraordinary courage; or
- b) have overcome adversity and become positive role models and/or helped their community; or
- c) face a number of challenges on a daily basis but don't give up; or
- d) someone who has shown exceptional courage, bravery and inspiration in the face of adversity; or
- e) someone with a fighting spirit who refuses to be beaten.
- What is the nature of YP's challenge?
- How long has YP faced this challenge e.g. from birth, early childhood, etc.?
- · How has it impacted on YP daily life in matters such as socialising, taking part in
- · Activities/sport, education?
- · What restrictions does the challenge impose?
- How well does YP cope with restrictions on the ability to lead a life like peers?
- What has YP achieved in terms of coping with/overcoming restrictions imposed by the challenge?

This is where **you** come in. Of all the young people you know, who live in Westhill and the surrounding areas, is there someone you could nominate for this award?

Nomination forms are available online at www.skeneparish. com or from our church office. The deadline is the end of September and you can find out more information on our website.

All those nominated will be recognised and an awards ceremony will be held in October.







The Physio says - knowledge is power

I love learning new things, and I love passing on knowledge. I like to teach my patients about their bodies, so that they have a better understanding of their condition. They're more likely to take my advice and do any exercises I give them if they know how and why it will help. We all learn all the time, but not always in a good way. Phobias are a learned behaviour. One experience of being swooped at by a seagull can result in a lifetime of a fear of birds, for example. Fortunately, learned behaviour can be un-learned. The brain is constantly learning and un-learning all sorts of things, which is called plasticity. So if we can use that to make our lives easier, what a great thing it is. A lot of the learning is unconscious. Nobody wants to have a phobia of spiders or birds. But often, to be free of unhelpful behaviour or thoughts, it takes conscious effort.

Learning a new skill also takes conscious effort, like learning to play the piano, or learning to drive. But after lots of practice, these become automatic and unconscious. Top sports people practice a lot, until their movements become unconscious. Having the right attitude of mind is essential too. Tiger Woods is a good example of a sportsman who plays better when he keeps his cool. Once Andy Murray had learned that tantrums on the tennis court weren't helpful, he started to win more matches. Staying calm and focussed is how to make it to the top, whether you're in sports or a concert pianist.

I would like everyone to know more about how pain works. It can be categorised into two types, acute pain and chronic pain. Acute pain is usually short-lived and helpful. It makes you change your behaviour in a way that helps you get over whatever is causing it, in the shortest time possible. For example if you trip and break your ankle, pain stops you walking on it until it heals, or until soon after the plaster cast is on.

Chronic pain lasts a long time, longer than is useful, beyond any healing time, so it's unhelpful. The most common example is chronic low back pain. Scans and X-Rays may show no reason for the pain, yet that pain can be debilitating. Unhelpful pain is a learned behaviour, usually unconscious, so the sufferer mustn't be blamed or accused of malingering. Pain is an output of the brain, and it's 'volume' is increased or decreased in response to our thoughts, past experiences, stress levels, and all sorts of other things. This can be true even when there is a serious injury. But if there's no injury or reason for the pain, then simply being reassured that you don't have a serious illness and you will get better, can have the effect of reducing the volume. To conclude this brief summary of pain, here's my new mantra, borrowed from two Australian colleagues I admire: 'know pain, know gain'. Sound familiar? The new spelling changes the meaning altogether. If you understand how pain works, you can help yourself by un-learning unhelpful pain, with so much to gain.





Do you have enough Zinc in your diet?

Have you been following nutrition advice to cut down on red meat and eat more fruit and vegetables? Or are you vegetarian/vegan and eat no meat at all?

Zinc is an important micronutrient and is required for the proper structure and function of proteins in the body. A lack of zinc in the diet can have a negative effect on health including suppressing the immune system (making you more susceptible to colds and infections), it has an effect on men's health (in the production of healthy sperm, and predisposing the prostate gland to infection), and helps maintain the integrity of the skin (so is used in treatment of nappy rash, dry skin, acne, etc.). Zinc may also influence chronic diseases such as heart disease.

Health experts advise eating less red meat and more fruit and veg, but most zinc in the diet comes from red meat so some groups of the population are at risk of zinc deficiency, especially vegans, vegetarians, low income families and the elderly.

Scientists at the Rowett Institute in Aberdeen, in collaboration with the James Hutton Institute are trying out a new way to improve zinc nutrition without altering peoples eating habits by biofortifying potatoes with zinc using normal farming methods. Potatoes are not only widely eaten throughout the world, being relatively cheap they are accessible to most people and they could be utilised by everyone including vegans and vegetarians to improve their zinc status.



LAWSONDALE'S NEW 3G FOOTBALL PITCH OPENS FOR BUSINESS



After 5 years of planning and a year of construction work the new, FIFA approved, 3G artificial football pitch at Lawsondale Westhill is ready for use. Its construction has been funded and organised by Westdyke Community Club and Lawsondale Sports Centre Trust with assistance from sportscotland and Aberdeenshire Council, as well as our much appreciated sponsor Nicol of Skene.



The pitch is further evidence of Westdyke CC's commitment to strengthening its position as a premier centre for football development in the North East.

The pitch is available at very attractive rates for use by Community Groups – including schools, charities, disability and senior citizen groups – during weekday mornings and afternoons.

We are also offering 5 or 6-a-side lets between 12.00 and 2.00pm on weekdays. 


