## WESTHILL & ELRICK COMMUNITY COUNCIL OFFICE BEARER'S REPORT

Since the last Bulletin, members of Westhill & Elrick Community Council (WECC), supported by many volunteers, have been busy out and about doing work to help to keep Westhill looking an attractive place to live and

work. This includes regular litter picks, attending to flower displays, spring cleaning the path network and, a significant amount of work in Denman Park. Thank you to all who gave and continue to give their time. As a Community Council, we couldn't achieve what we do for the community without the help of volunteers (see Green Spaces article on page 73).

#### Your chance to influence

WECC has places for 17 members plus the possibility of co-opting Associate members for a period of time to support us in a particular project or with a particular topic. At the moment, we have some vacancies. Aberdeenshire Council has now set a universal election date for all community councils. This will be in September and nearer the time there will be a lot of publicity and information on this new arrangement. We hope that this will stimulate interest from people seeking election. We would particularly like to see more representation from people with young families. We recognise that people lead busy lives, but apart from a meeting once a month on the second Thursday evening, everything else is optional. Members find that they can take on roles and tasks to suit their own interests, skills and experience and generally find that they get a lot out of being a member of the Community Council.

## **Community Action Plan**

Thank you to everyone who stopped and spoke to us at our stand at the shopping centre over the weekend of 19/20 April. It was very cold and windy a lot of the time! The purpose of this event was to talk to people to see if this validated the information that we had gathered through an online survey and focus groups. It was also an opportunity to share any other thoughts with us about what you would like to see happening in Westhill. We are now close to finalising the Community Action Plan. Over the next few months, we hope to shape up a range of initiatives to improve people's lives in Westhill. We also hope to see some people, who would like to see things happen, getting involved to help make them happen. The Community Council can facilitate, advise and encourage, but it can't take on all the various ideas that have come forward. These include a sports/community hub, adult learning opportunities ('evening classes'), informal places to meet, chat, have a coffee, both indoor and outdoor, a range of issues to discuss regarding the shopping centre, activities for young people, public transport, paths and open spaces, also a major play park somewhere in Westhill. This list is not conclusive/exhaustive, there is more!

## **Shopping Centre**

Most people will probably be aware that Westhill Shopping Centre has been sold. We met recently with a representative of the new owner. They will also manage it day to day which is different to the previous arrangements where the owner contracted day to day management to a third party company. We were encouraged by a very constructive and positive meeting and feel confident that a good working relationship will develop. See article on the new parking operator on page 55.

## **Aberdeenshire Lieutenancy**

Thank you for including a Lieutenancy page in your wonderful Westhill Bulletin and congratulations to all those who contribute to such an informative and interesting community publication. Many people may not be too familiar with the work of the Aberdeenshire Lieutenancy. One of the Lieutenancy's roles is to ensure that messages of congratulations are delivered from The King and myself to those celebrating their 60th, 70th or 75th wedding anniversaries and 100th and 105th Birthdays.

#### **Pavement Parking**

I wrote in the previous Bulletin regarding pavement parking which became illegal at the beginning of 2024. Many of you have written to me on this, with photographs, and it is clearly an area of concern

Aberdeenshire Council have advised that patrols have been taking place in Westhill which has resulted in 33 warning notices being issued to cars parked in contravention of this legislation. As this is relatively new legislation the Council have adopted a practice of advising motorists of their offence, and in due course, this will result in fines being issued.

Please continue to report any vehicles you encounter in contravention of the legislation and together we can make the pavements a safer place for everyone.

## Congratulations to Westhill's Porter Pharmacy Being Awarded Pharmacy of the Year

Porter Pharmacy Westhill was nominated for Pharmacy of the Year at the Scottish Independent Retail Awards in Glasgow. Out of all the independent pharmacies in Scotland, to win this award was an outstanding and well-deserved achievement especially considering the history of the pharmacy before it became Porter Pharmacy. Changes which Porter's have made included a refit making the shopping experience more inviting and more



streamlined; the 24-hour collection robot; and the hyperbaric oxygen chamber. The changes made contributed to their win and we as their customers are ultimately the beneficiaries. Being nominated for the award required submission of evidence to the judging panel and a public vote was included in the process. Hardly surprising customers voted their support of this important and vital service in the Westhill community where good customer care is a priority.

## UCAN's Fund Raising Target of £2.5m to Fund a Urological Cancer Diagnostic Centre Want to Make a Difference? You Can With UCAN

I recently attended the launch of a local urological cancer charity fund raising campaign led by Professor James N'Dow. UCAN's goal is to fund, at a cost of £2.5 million, a Urological Cancer Rapid Diagnostic Centre (RDC) at Aberdeen Royal Infirmary. The RDC aims to enable patients with a suspected urological cancer to be seen quicker, and to have all scans and/or diagnostic procedures during a single visit to hospital. The RDC aims to significantly reduce the time for diagnosis, which will improve cancer treatment outcomes and reduce anxiety for patients and their families across the North of Scotland. Currently the time for a urological diagnosis is unacceptably long (4-6 months). The statistics are stark- in NE Scotland 1 in 5 men will be diagnosed with urological cancer; 1 in 3 men with prostate cancers are diagnosed too late; and 1500 men and women are diagnosed with urological cancer annually. ## Councillor Fatima Joji

As of the time of writing (5th May 2024), it has been precisely two years since I had the honour of being elected to serve as your local councillor. I remain deeply humbled by the trust and confidence you have put in me to represent you and our community as one of four local councillors. Looking ahead, there are myriad opportunities for us to continue advancing together as a community. My door is always open, and I warmly welcome any chance to engage with constituents in person for discussions about matters of concern, or virtually, or over the phone. Please don't hesitate to approach me for a chat should you see me around Westhill.

#### **Anti-Social Behaviour Concerns**

I note the number of correspondences I have received about anti-social behaviour in Westhill, and I am grateful for residents who have reached out to raise awareness and engage in discussions about potential solutions.

A particularly known case concerned one of our local businesses being the target of an unpleasant episode of anti-social behaviour. Following the incident, I met with the owner of the local business. The meeting was positive where we also discussed opportunities to positively engage our kids for the benefit of our community.

It was great to see the response and reassurance from Police Scotland Northeast following recent reports. Their proactive approach is essential for the safety and well-being of our children and families, our local businesses – which deserve a secure operating environment – and the peace of mind of restaurant visitors.

Westhill is a beautiful town and thankfully, such occurrences are few in number. We can hopefully work on steps to ensure this does not happen again.

#### **Nesting Gulls**

This is a topic that has landed in my in-box. For anyone who has contacted me over the past two years, you might be pleased to know that Aberdeenshire Council is currently piloting solar-powered sonar devices at three locations across the region, including Westhill School, with the aim of dissuading gulls from nesting.

Installed in April, these devices are designed to be non-invasive to the birds and will be in place for around 10-12 weeks. Should this trial prove successful, Aberdeenshire Council will explore the possibility of deploying additional devices in other identified hot spot areas in preparation for next year's nesting season

Whatever the weather there is still a lot to do in the garden – preparation for the summer time to get your cuttings out of the greenhouse and into the ground under a cloche to harden off for a few days (keeping an eye on the weather). As the ground is warming up remember to stake taller plants as the wind can still be a bit harsh. Even with all the rain it is a good idea to have some type of water container handy, in case of drought, save rainwater.

I planted three types of potatoes in March. First earlies second earlies and main crop, they are just starting to come through. Onions and garlic are doing okay, carrots just sown, tomatoes are having a hard time, just have to wait.

## SPEAR Physiotherapy asks.....should we Stretch?

Stretching has become less popular in recent years. You may recall incorporating a significant amount of stretching into warm-up routines. Nowadays, stretching is not commonly included in warm-ups and is often replaced by active movements. Foam rolling has become a common substitute for stretching in cool down routines.

## Why is stretching a lost art?

The effectiveness of stretching has been a topic of debate, with research suggesting a limited short-term impact. However, Yoga has been around for centuries and continues to show positive results so what is going on? Recent studies in the last few years have discovered new evidence indicating that stretching does indeed increase muscle length, maybe just not in the way we thought.

Julian's (2024) recently wrote an article for Physio Matters outlining new research which found the following benefits to stretching:

- Stretching can increase the size of the muscle. For people that are too frail to do resistance training this may be a nicer, gentler and more enjoyable way to exercise.
- Stretching reduces arterial stiffness reducing heart rate and blood pressure. Stretching therefore has relaxation benefits. This ties nicely into what we know about Yoga.
- Stretching makes muscles more resistant to overload, giving injury prevention benefits and therefore can help us to train harder.
- Muscles are primed for performance without losing tension through range, which means it can be performed safely in a warm-up. This is contrary to current practice in the last decade when stretching in a warm-up has been discouraged.
- Muscles are capable of function at greater range of lengths. This is important for activities that
  require us to work into big ranges of movement like dancing. Interestingly stretching remains
  important in the world of dance.

Considering the numerous benefits associated with stretching, is it time for us to reconsider its importance in our fitness routines?

The evidence shows that stretching should be a vital component of any fitness regimen, independent of age, health and personal circumstances. The effects are so wide ranging we should perhaps recommend it for all.

## Aberdeen's Childline office celebrates 20th Birthday

Aberdeen volunteers continue to be there for young people in distress

Staff and volunteers in Aberdeen got together in May to celebrate 20 years of Childline in Aberdeen. During this time the Aberdeen office has experienced an alarming increase in the number of calls and online contacts, just last year delivering nearly 14,000 counselling sessions. And more than 6 million children nationwide have benefited from the service since it began in 1986.

Thousands of children speak to a Childline counsellor in Scotland every year because they feel they have no else to turn to about their worries or concerns. Volunteers listen, assess and explore feelings and options with callers, who contact Childline by phone and online about a range of issues including bullying, abuse, neglect, sexuality and pregnancy.

Formal training or qualifications in counselling are not required, as full training is provided to all successful applicants. All that's needed is a commitment to children, an open mind and an ability to listen and support young people who need to talk.



### **Kingshill Parish Church**

What makes a good 'ending'?

Do you like all the loose ends tied up?

Would you prefer a happy ending to a cliffhanger?

I'm old enough to remember the excitement of waiting for and watching the ending to Dallas, back in the days when television was an event. But even more recently, there has

been much debate over the endings to Game of Thrones and Line of Duty. It cannot be an easy task, to bring to a close complex storylines, where the characters have grown and developed over many years.

Luke's gospel ends with the beautiful story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus. John's gospel has Peter being reinstated by Jesus and taking on the ministry of shepherding the new community of believers.

Matthew has something much punchier. Within it, we find what is sometimes referred to as the great commission. The disciples, gathered on a mountaintop in Galilee, are instructed by Jesus, to go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the 3-fold name of God, and teaching them everything he has commanded. A pretty weighty task that has passed from generation to generation and which not only marks the beginning of the early church, but which also continues to be the mission of the church today. As T.S. Eliot puts it, "...to make an end is to make a beginning. The end is where we start from "

As I write this, I am making my own ending. From 1st July I will move from being parish minister at Kingshill Parish Church to being the presbytery clerk for the North East and Northern Isles. The job involves providing strategic and organisational guidance and advice for congregations and members of Presbytery and is one into which I feel a strong sense of calling.

Whilst I am excited to take on the challenge of this new role, I am sad to be saying goodbye to the congregation and the parish. Being part of the community here has been a wonderful experience. I've loved spending time getting to know so many people, from across the generations. It has also been a delight to serve alongside others and to offer support wherever I could. From the schools to our local care home and sheltered housing, as well as being part of our response to the arrival of asylum seekers in our locale. There is much that I will miss.

But now is the time for a new season, both for me and for the congregation. In this ending, there are new beginnings, which will unfold over time.

Thank you for your friendship and support over the last 12 and a bit years. May I take this opportunity to say how wonderful I think our community is and to wish all those involved with its growth and development the very best in the future.



### **Westhill Tennis Club**

As activity at Westhill Tennis Club picks up again ahead of the summer, we thought it would be worth sharing the many benefits the sport can bring to your mental and physical health.

**Fitness** – Tennis provides both aerobic and anaerobic training. The average point in tennis includes bursts of activity and acts to condition our bodies the same way interval training would do. This has a profoundly positive effect on our heart and lungs with studies showing that playing just three hours a week reduces the risk of heart disease by over 50%. Tennis is a sport for all ages, genders, sizes and expertise levels, with benefits including maintaining healthy body composition, bone health, muscle strength and balance.

**Strong bones and muscles** – Playing tennis on a regular basis leads to stronger, healthier bones. Over two dozen studies have analysed bone health in tennis players at all different levels with most showing that bone density and strength increase because of tennis participation. This is most noticeable in the spine and hips and the dominant arm of the tennis player.

**Improved immunity** – There is a wealth of evidence to suggest that immunity is enhanced through exercise. Moderate exercise improves the immune system by increasing the number and strength of immune system cells, as well as increasing immune system efficiency. As tennis is both physically and mentally demanding, reason would suggest that it is one of the best sporting activities to give our immunity a boost.

**Better coordination** – Tennis leads to better hand-eye coordination because of the requirement to constantly judge the timing between the oncoming ball and the correct contact point. This combined with the frequent changes of direction and fast responsiveness to a moving target (the ball), tennis players generally will demonstrate improved agility, good balance, and body awareness (proprioception) which helps prevent accidents and falls throughout life.

**Increased cognition and brain power** – From alertness to tactical thinking, tennis enhances the ability for rapid and clever thinking and creative problem solving. Tennis players possess enhanced abilities in motion detection, speed awareness, processing and timing. Tennis also gets the senses fired up with faster eye tracking, hearing and touch perception. It is also shown that tennis enables our brains to remodel, building new neural (nerve) connections and pathways to create these positive effects.

**Increased concentration** – Tennis also dramatically improves the ability to concentrate, which assists with the completion of tasks that require problem solving skills, revealing the ability to persevere with high-level cognitive tasks. Activities requiring an increased level of focus for a prolonged duration can include school or university studies, learning another language, budgeting and logistical activities, such as those related to travel and schedules.

**Emotional resilience** – Tennis involves physical, mental, social, and emotional challenges. This increases a person's capacity to deal with perceived and actual stress and challenges and improves the emotional characteristics which foster resilience and wellness.

**More than a sport** – Perhaps the biggest health benefit that tennis gives us is its 'life lessons'. Players are continuously tested in how they react to situations and deal with adversity whilst developing a competitive and a winning mentality. A study that compared behaviour patterns of adolescent tennis players with those who do not participate in sport, demonstrated that the tennis players develop more autonomy, assertiveness, personality and an ability to persevere to reach their goals.

### **New Parking Operator for Shopping Centre**

Residents may have noticed that new green parking signs were put up in the Shopping Centre car park in early May. The parking operator is now 'Your Parking Space'. The main changes from previous operator are:

- You still get 3 hours of free parking. If you have parked for more than 3 hours you can pay a small charge by scanning the app on the signs, put in your car reg and time when you entered the car park, and pay the charge shown just before leaving the car park. The charges are: 3 to 4 hours £0.90; 4 to 6 hours £2: 6 to 24 hours £3.
- You can now leave the car park and return within an hour with no penalty charge.
- Parking in the bays outside the vets is for Authorised Vehicles Only, these are for vehicles with permits. If you are going to the vets you should park in the main car park



• If you are going to Duncano's restaurant you can still give your car reg and stay for more than 3 hours for no charge.



## **Westhill Paths and Green Spaces Group Update**

Spring has certainly sprung, weeds and all! It's time to ensure that paths are kept clear of overhanging vegetation, and fortunately the community is well served by a small army – let's call it a team – of volunteers to help do that.

Over these last few weeks and months since my last report the team has been warming up by tackling some of the planted areas in **Denman Park** that the Council's Landscape Services team hasn't been able to get to during the dormant season. So we came to an arrangement where volunteers do the pruning and Landscape Services dispose of the waste, usually by chipping.



Meanwhile, another team has been keeping an eye on the tubs at the junction of Westhill Drive and Old Skene Road, both on the roundabout and at the "green wall".

The Community Council couldn't undertake these tasks of keeping our green spaces tidy if it weren't for the help of our volunteers. So, a huge thank you to you all. You know who you are!

In terms of green spaces, the highlight of the summer is undoubtedly going to be the **path and bridge improvement work in Denman Park**, designed to make the park a more engaging green space to spend time in. This was only possible due to the community's support of WECC's funding application to the Scottish Government's Place Based Investment Programme. Work is ongoing as I write this, with the contractor due to finish at the end of June.

Meantime, another Council contractor is installing a "downstream defender" unit designed to improve water filtration and the quality of water flowing into the **Denman Ponds** area, which in time, should improve the habitat for wildlife.

#### **Ongoing Maintenance**

Also in May, we hope to patch some of the wetter sections of the **Orbital Trail** with quarry material after the wear and tear of footfall over an exceptionally wet winter. Our focus will be on sections alongside the burn at **Lawsondale**, and on the farm track on the northern edge of **Meadowlands**.

In June, we should take delivery of summer bedding plants to populate the tubs and hanging baskets around the "green wall".

Over the next few months of the growing season, until September, most of our work will be keeping the Orbital Trail paths clear of weeds and overhanging vegetation, but we also hope to find time and resources to remove the remaining **boardwalk in Carnie Woods**, working alongside the City Council's Ranger service.




