Chairperson's Report

Hello everyone, welcome to the Summer Bulletin



The Ward 13 Councillor's report in the Spring Bulletin contained details of a survey that WECC were conducting to gauge the likely demand if a bus service to the Blacklaws Brae turning circle was reinstated. 577 leaflets with a QR code to access the survey were delivered with the Spring Bulletin to homes in the areas where it is believed such an extended bus service would be of most benefit to residents. 217 responses were received (a



return rate of 38%), with the highest return rates coming from the three areas furthest away from the nearest active bus stop in Hays Way -Westhill Heights, Meadowlands and Hilltop. The responses showed that there was overwhelming support for reinstating the service and indicated a potential 350 additional users. Accordingly WECC are proposing a 6-month trial based on recommissioning existing infrastructure on the disused route to form a loop of just under 1 mile long. A detailed report has been sent to Aberdeenshire Council Transport Dept. and Stagecoach and a meeting has been arranged to discuss the survey results in detail.

Westhill's Charity Fund Raiser Supreme Raises £2 million for Good Causes

Aberdeen Ashvale Chipper's boss Stuart Devine MBE is a Westhill resident having lived here for over 30 years. Recently he was quoted in the P&J listing his favourite things about Westhill, including: plenty of attractive parks, particularly the upgrading of Denman and interesting walks; supermarkets and shops for which Westhill is the 'destination of choice', not just for locals but from the wider area particularly now with the ease of access from the AWPR and free car parking; the variety and quality of restaurants along with the popular fast food outlets Westhill is in the view of Stuart a great place to live.

Whilst Stuart's views of Westhill are acknowledged and would be agreed by its residents it is his involvement with the charitable organisation at the Ashvale Chipper which was of interest to us. For many years he has dabbled in fundraising, raising money initially for the Fisherman's Mission and the RLNI and some 15 years ago he became aware that local charities were looking for a venue to raise funds. As Stuart had a backroom at his restaurant to accommodate bookings this has turned out to be the ideal solution. After a feed of fish and chips he runs a video Race Night. The booking diary is full hosting some 200 functions each year and raising some £200K annually and during his involvement this amounts to over £2million. Stuart is understandably immensely proud that he has helped a wide range of local charities and organisations including schools, churches, kids' clubs, sports clubs and recently the Westhill Rotary Club. According to Stuart he wants to help those charities and organisations who want to raise money to make a difference to someone's life and for him and his team it is being able to help. Clearly this is what he does.

Costco Petrol Station

At a recent area committee meeting, the 4 Westhill councillors were pleased to approve the planning application for an additional petrol station in Westhill submitted by Costco, which will include a plot of EV charging stations.

This will be located on Prospect Road, opposite the Tesco petrol station and is scheduled to open in late 2025 (possibly November), for the use of Costco members only.

Foundation Apprenticeships

Build Brighter Futures for Aberdeenshire Students Real-world learning boosts skills, confidence, and career prospects across the region.

Foundation Apprenticeships (FAs) are transforming how young people in Aberdeenshire prepare for life after school. These innovative programmes give senior pupils the chance to gain nationally recognised qualifications while getting hands-on experience in real workplaces.

Offered to S5 and S6 students, FAs combine academic study with vocational training and work placements. Pupils develop practical skills in key sectors such as Engineering, IT, Health & Social Care, Business, Construction, Automotive, and Hospitality. Industry partners play a key role in shaping the curriculum, ensuring that the training reflects real employer needs.

Students are supported throughout by teachers, mentors, and training providers, and they leave school better equipped for employment, apprenticeships, college, or university.

"We get real life experience, in real life environments, with real life people," said one Aberdeenshire FA student — a sentiment echoed across participating schools.

The impact has been significant: Attendance among FA students has increased by 30%. Engagement has risen by over 50%. Students are achieving higher qualifications and progressing into positive destinations. Employability and workplace skills have been greatly enhanced. Employer partnerships are stronger, creating direct career pathways.

'Mrs Reid, Head Teacher said 'Westhill Academy has offered Foundation Apprenticeships since they began in Aberdeenshire, and the number of our pupils taking these has grown every year. This year, nearly 20% of our S4-6 pupils are undertaking a Foundation Apprenticeship, demonstrating that these qualifications add to and complement the curricular opportunities we offer young people in Westhill. FAs are increasingly recognised as relevant qualifications by employers and further and higher education organisations, which adds positively to our learners' attainment and onward destinations, and they also benefit from the 'real life' experience of the work placement.'

Household Recycling Centre

Unfortunately, a popular item in our mailboxes at the current time is problems with bookings at the Westhill Household Recycling centre. There have been a number of weekend closures recently which has been caused by staff shortages which means that the centre could not operate in an HSE compliant manner.

We are working with the waste management team to get some urgent solutions put in place as this is obviously a busy time as summer garden waste becomes an issue for many of our residents. We are confident that full staffing levels will be in place by early June, which should eliminate the problem. As a temporary alternative, there are seasonal green waste disposal sites at Blackburn, Kemnay and Kintore which are within close proximity of Westhill and avoids the need to travel to the main HRCs at either Banchory or Inverurie.

We shall be monitoring this going forward to ensure that the solutions are put in place at the earliest opportunity to ensure a safe and workable solution for staff and visitors.

A further point to note is that the booking system is here to stay; during normal capacity operations most people can get a slot same day, even at weekends, and this system has worked effectively, especially in reducing traffic management issues on Westdyke Avenue and Wellgrove Road when there were previously long queues disrupting traffic under the previous "open to all" system.

ARMY CADET FORCE: Shaping Young Lives in the North East since 1943

Youth organisation transforms futures for local boys and girls through challenge, training, and opportunity.

With this article being written during the commemoration of VE Day (Victory in Europe) and ahead of VJ Day (Victory over Japan) in August, it feels especially fitting to highlight the briefing we received from the Commandant focusing on the importance of their youth development programme. This was during a visit to the ACF training weekend at Boddam where some 90 young people were involved developing their life skills, widening their knowledge and having fun. As visitors we were impressed with this well organised programme.

Since 1943, the Army Cadet Force (ACF) has been providing young people in the Northeast of Scotland with opportunities to grow, lead, and achieve. Part of a national organisation with roots dating back to 1859, the ACF offers teenage boys and girls, aged 12 to 18, a structured environment where they can build life-changing skills.

The ACF is much more than a military-themed club. While cadets learn traditional skills like fieldcraft, drill, and shooting, they also develop leadership qualities, teamwork, self-confidence, and resilience. Activities include navigation, adventure training, sports, cyber communications, music, and volunteering—all designed to prepare young people for a successful future.

Many cadets go on to achieve nationally recognised awards such as the Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE) and Scottish Vocational Qualifications (SVQs). These credentials, along with their experiences in the cadets, often give them an edge when applying to universities, jobs, or even the armed forces.

Numerous success stories have emerged from the ranks of the ACF. Former cadets have become officers in the military, paramedics, police officers, and business leaders—each crediting their cadet experience for shaping their path. One former cadet shared, "It gave me direction at a time when I didn't know what I wanted. The confidence I gained helped me get where I am today."

Cadets are encouraged to take on responsibility as they progress, helping to train younger members and serve as positive role models. Opportunities for travel across the UK and abroad further enrich the experience.

Importantly, the ACF is affordable. Thanks to government and charitable support, most activities are heavily subsidised, ensuring access for young people from all backgrounds.

Why Aberdeenshire Council is Forecasting a Funding Crisis?

Along with other councillors we have campaigned over the Fair Funding annual budget allocation. The financial position once again reveals the Shire receives one of the lowest levels of funding per resident in Scotland in spite of a modest overall increase in our annual allocation.

In the 2025-26 financial year, the council will receive £627.7 million from the Scottish Government, up from £608.5 million the previous year. While this represents a 3.2% increase, the funding per head remains far below the national average.

At just £2,375 per person, Aberdeenshire ranks 29th out of Scotland's 32 councils in terms of funding per resident. By comparison, neighbouring Moray receives £2,471 per head, Aberdeen City £2,218, while the Shetland Islands top the list with £5,229 per resident.

If Aberdeenshire were funded at the national average, it would gain an additional £51 million annually, money that could be invested in essential services such as education, infrastructure, and social care.

The current funding model is determined by the Scottish Government in partnership with the Convention of Scottish Local Authorities (COSLA). The formula considers population size, deprivation, and specific local needs.

Much of the council's budget is restricted by ring-fencing, where funds must be spent on nationally set priorities. For example, funding earmarked for the expansion of early learning and childcare provision cannot be redirected to other local services, even in times of financial pressure.

Looking ahead, the council faces an £80 million funding gap from 2026-27 onwards. Unless funding levels are addressed, the shortfall will severely impact service delivery.

Infrastructure projects like rural road repairs and bridge maintenance are already under strain, and in social care, we're seeing rising demand for home support services for elderly residents. There is not enough funding to match the financial outlook which is increasingly unsustainable. Without a fairer funding settlement, it will be difficult to maintain even the most critical services.

Along with other councillors we'll continue to campaign and lobby the Scottish Government for a review of the funding formula but don't hold your breath to expect any change in the formula.

4 Simple Exercises to Try at Home

Squat



Stand in front of a chair. Push your bottom back and descend towards the chair. Stop just before the chair and stand back up by pushing your weight through the middle of vour feet.

3x20

Heel Raise



Stand with feet hip-width apart and slowly lift your heels off the ground, then slowly lower them back down

3x12

Single Leg Stand



Stand on one leg while keeping the other leg slightly bent. Hold onto a chair for support if needed.

2x 60 seconds

Wall Push-Up



Stand with your hands on the wall. Step backwards until you are leaning forward. Lower yourself slowly towards the wall by bending your elbows. Then return.

3x12

Current guidelines are to exercise twice per week for at least 4-8 weeks, alongside regular cardio exercise such as brisk walking. You can progress by holding weights such as plastic bottles of water, and/or increasing the number of sets and repetitions you perform. Alternatively, book in for a consultation with one of our physios wherewe can tailor a program to suit your specific needs and goals.

"These four movements can help seniors build strength and improve balance, making daily activities easier and safer.



Skene Medical Group Update

As I write this on a warm (ish) Spring day I hope it is a sign of some consistent good weather to come over the next few months. We have some important information to share with you regarding changes at Skene Medical Practice.

Mental Health Review forms

If you take medication to support your mental health, you may have noticed that we have introduced a new Medication Review Form. This form includes a brief set of questions about your mental wellbeing and how you're managing with your current medication.

When your GP renews your regular prescription, they may ask our admin team to contact you to complete this form if it's been a while since your last review.

Our goal is simply to ensure that your mental health treatment remains safe and effective. The Medication Review Form helps us determine if you're doing well on your medication or if you'd benefit from speaking directly with a doctor.

If your medication is working well and you're not experiencing any issues, we will continue prescribing it as usual. However, if you're facing any difficulties, have questions, or feel a change in your medication might help, our administrative team will arrange an appointment for you.

The Medication Review Form can be found on the Skene Medical Group website under the Mental Health tab on the right hand side of the homepage. These forms can only be completed if you have been invited to do so by the practice - we will not accept any forms that are returned to us if you have not been asked to fill one out.

We are already using a similar review form to help monitor Hormone Replacement Therapy (HRT) prescriptions and we find that it is an efficient way of keeping in touch with you while ensuring that medications are prescribed safely on a recurring basis. We are therefore likely to roll out more of these in the future for other medications or conditions which require regular review.

On the day appointments

At present, the practice runs an appointment system where routine appointments can be made in advance with emergency and urgent medical matters being managed on the day by a team of duty doctors and advanced nurse practitioners. General practice has been and is getting busier. We have noticed this, particularly, in the demand for on the day medical attention. We have responded to this in a number of ways over the last few years- the amount of doctor time at the practice has increased by more than 33% since 2018 and the size of the duty team has more than doubled since the coronavirus pandemic. Despite this, we are seeing an unsustainable demand for on the day appointments and are no longer able to meet this in the same way. From 1st June 2025, the practice will, at busy times, introduce a cap on the number of on the day appointments available. When this is reached, we will no longer be able to accept any more requests for an appointment that day. This will be communicated to you if you contact the practice via our phone system. At this point, your options will be to either seek medical attention via A&E in an emergency; via 111 after 6pm for an urgent matter or to try the practice again on the next working day. We are sorry to have to announce this but, despite all our efforts, we have no further options. A number of practices locally and nationally have already had to do this and it is in line with British Medical Association (BMA) recommendations on safe and sustainable working practices. We have tried to avoid this significant step until now. We appreciate your understanding on this matter.

Challenging Patient Behaviour

Westhill is a great community to be a part of and the vast majority of interactions with our patients are very positive - our team is treated with kindness and respect, for which we are truly grateful. However, in recent times, we have regrettably seen an increase in unacceptable and abusive behaviour directed towards our staff.

Building positive relationships with our patients is one of the most rewarding aspects of practising medicine. A good staff-patient relationship is essential - it not only enhances the quality of care you receive but also boosts morale among our team, enabling us to work at our best. This is something we are proud to say that we manage to achieve most of the time.

Sadly, a small minority of people behave disrespectfully and in an unreasonable manner towards our

practice staff. As a partnership, we have come to the conclusion that we cannot allow this to continue. We understand that many of you feel frustrated. We are all frustrated with the pressures currently facing the healthcare system, but this frustration does not justify aggressive or abusive behaviour toward anyone at the practice.

Please be mindful of the following two points:

1. The availability of appointments is largely outwith our control.

Simply put, increasing demand for appointments at Skene exceeds availability, despite increasing the total available doctor time by approximately one-third over the past seven years. There has been a longstanding national shortfall in training sufficient numbers of medical professionals to meet the increasing demand as well as inadequate healthcare funding. These systemic problems are not the fault of our practice staff and allowing your frustrations to result in unacceptable behaviour towards us is counterproductive.

2. Our reception and management teams are doing a very difficult job.

Receptionists are often the first to assess your medical needs and have to determine the appropriate care pathway based on limited information. They must be able to recognise when symptoms indicate an emergency, such as a heart attack or stroke, and swiftly redirect patients to emergency services. This is an immense responsibility. They must also ensure that everyone has the same opportunity to access routine appointments while identifying cases that require urgent, same-day care. They do all of this, including a range of other administrative tasks, while working within the practice protocols, which have been carefully developed by the partnership to deliver care as efficiently as possible. Regularly facing abusive interactions from the public can undermine their confidence and impact morale. Dealing with these challenging encounters means that we have less time to help you access the care you need.

Our reception and administrative teams work hard and consistently exceed expectations. Having previously worked in various medical practices, I can confidently say our team here at Skene is exceptional.

Going forward we will be taking an even stronger position on abusive and aggressive behaviour. This includes a zero-tolerance approach, and in repeated or serious cases, we will seek to have that individual removed from our patient list in line with the recommendations of the BMA

It is worth noting that the BMA makes reference to different forms of unacceptable behaviour aside from behaviour that is overtly aggressive, unpleasant, or threatening. For example, unreasonable demands or persistent, unjustified criticism can have a huge impact on service provision, inevitably affecting the care we can provide to the rest of our patients.

Having said this, we very much welcome constructive feedback. Healthy dialogue helps us continuously improve and nothing about our firmer approach to inappropriate behaviour should deter you from letting us know your honest thoughts about our service.

To the vast majority of our patients, our message is simple: thank you for your continued kindness, patience, and understanding. We deeply appreciate your ongoing support while we try to deliver the best care that we can in the face of increasing challenges.

Inhalers recycling

Finally, inhalers are a significant source of carbon emissions and cannot be recycled with household waste. If they end up in landfill any remaining gases are released into the atmosphere. 50 million inhalers are prescribed annually in the UK and only 0.5% of these are recycled. Local pharmacies can recycle these appropriately and the practice now has 2 inhaler recycling bins which you are welcome to use.



Note that you can come to the shed any time we are open. This works best if you know what you want, and our staff will know if we have it. You can phone to check if we have what you want (contact details below or on the website).

Using the Shed for tool sales has been surprisingly successful as of course there is no passing trade, we hope to get a boost when we are at the shops, and it helps with the interaction with residents as we can discuss joining and what we do.

A new series of meetings have been held at the Shed- run by Abilitynet, they are an introduction to the use of IT and include time for individual questions on using their own equipment. We have stopped now but hope to restart in the winter.

We refurbished benches for Blackhills Place and Court, before and after shots on right.

The Westhill and Elrick Community Council gave us the money to do this.





At the Centre, traditional daily morning, midday and evening practices aside, we focus in learning to calm the very busy, sometimes crazy mind in order to see how our thoughts run wild & so run our lives. By taking back control of that wild, busy mind, we learn to take back control and work with our mind to be where we want it to be.

The classic definition of Mindfulness is to be able to be 'fully present', on purpose (i.e. intentionally), in each moment, with whatever is happening, when it's happening without distraction. This is why do so much outreach teaching and practice for free within various settings such as our regular Mindfulness Monday at the Aberdeen Health Village, online Wednesday zoom practices, short public courses and one-off tasters including with various departments in the NHS and other charities. In the last year we have offered three short courses in the Westhill area and over thirty people have benefitted from our sharing knowledge, experience and practices.

The Varapunya Meditation Centre is a small Buddhist centre, focusing on traditional teachings and practices in what is known as the Theravada ('Th' pronounced 'T') tradition.






In the last Bulletin we shared our ambitious plans for building a new space at the Centre so we can bring short courses and retreats to the Centre rather than renting space across Aberdeen & Aberdeenshire. The foundations of a £200k dedicated space for teaching and practice were laid in the late autumn and the main building has been largely completed over the spring, with new footpaths, veranda, lighting and solar energy. This will hold up to 40/50 people comfortably and more for our three or four special events each year. We expect to open sometime in July and we will have a more formal opening with special blessing next year.

Once the building has been handed over (not yet!),

if you are walking in the area please do go and look around it and walk in our fields and woodland. If we are 'at home' come and have a chat – there is one resident monk who speaks good English, sometimes visiting monks and also there are our volunteers.

You are also welcome to come and experience our events through the year. Coming up are our Interfaith Mindfulness Day on Saturday 17th May; Vesak Day on 18th May celebrating the Buddha's birth, enlightenment and death; and we have a Vesak retreat on the 24th May. Of course, by the time you read this, these dates will be past. So, if you are interested in knowing more, feel free to speak with the resident monk Ajahn Sujan or come along to a Wednesday evening teaching and meditation practice. 


